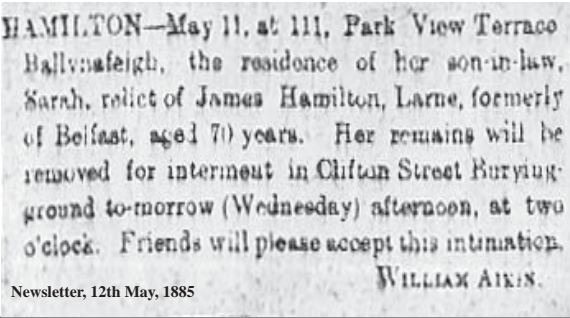


Belfast map of 1850 showing the cemetery

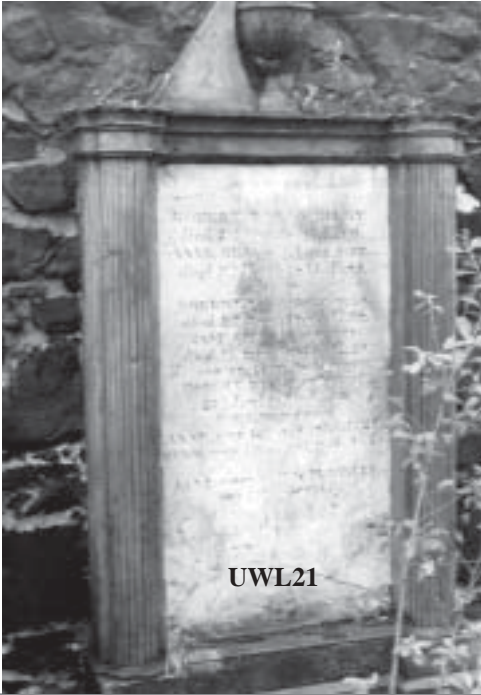

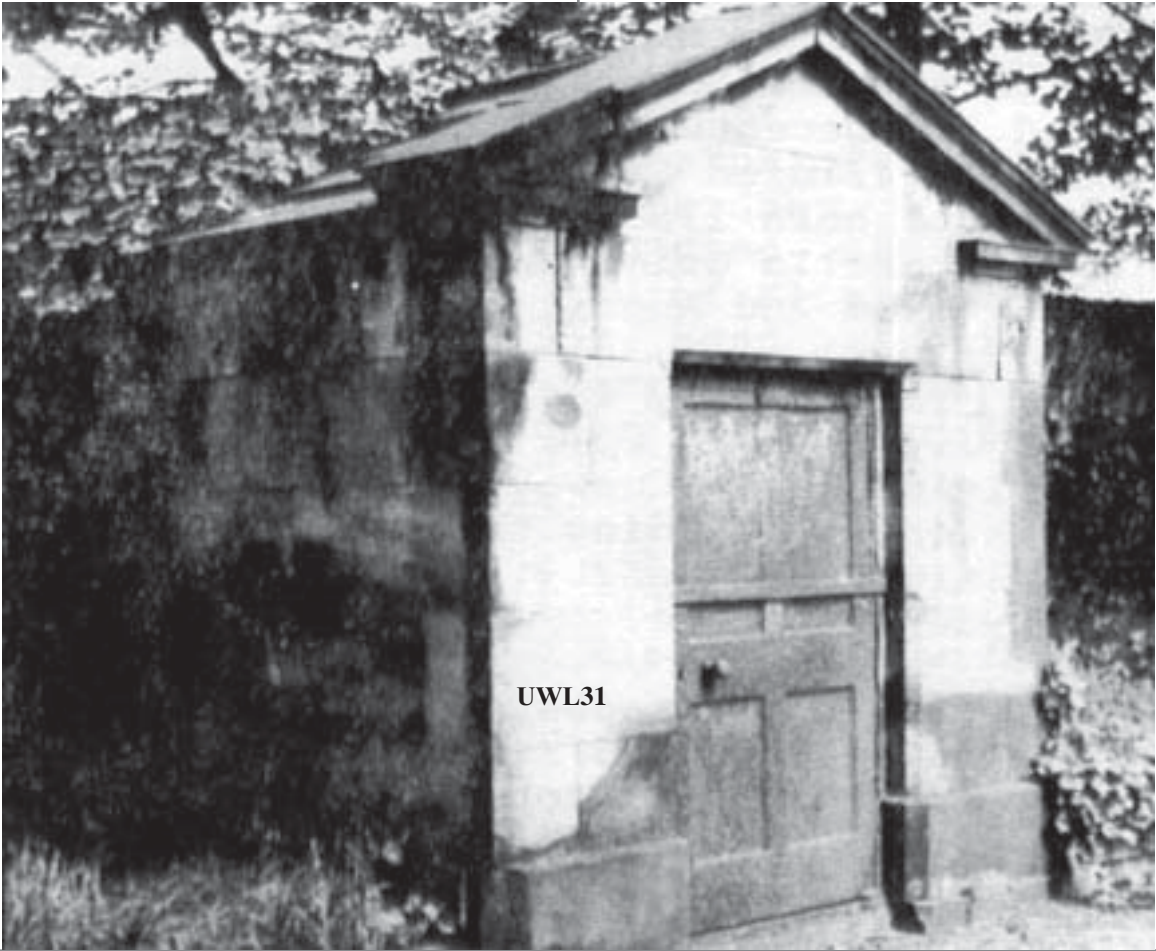

On the 12th of May 1909 a coffin was placed in this
grave containing the supposed remains of the United
Irishmen leader Henry Joy McCracken on the same
date the tombstone to his sister Mary Ann was erected
(Left).
His bones were placed in a strong coffer together with
a sealed phial containing a parchment with the
following: -

*These bones were dug up in the old graveyard in
High Street in 1902 and from several
circumstances are believed to be those of Henry
Joy McCracken. They were reverently treated
and were placed here by Robert May, of Belfast,
12th May 1909, when the monument was placed
to his beloved sister.*

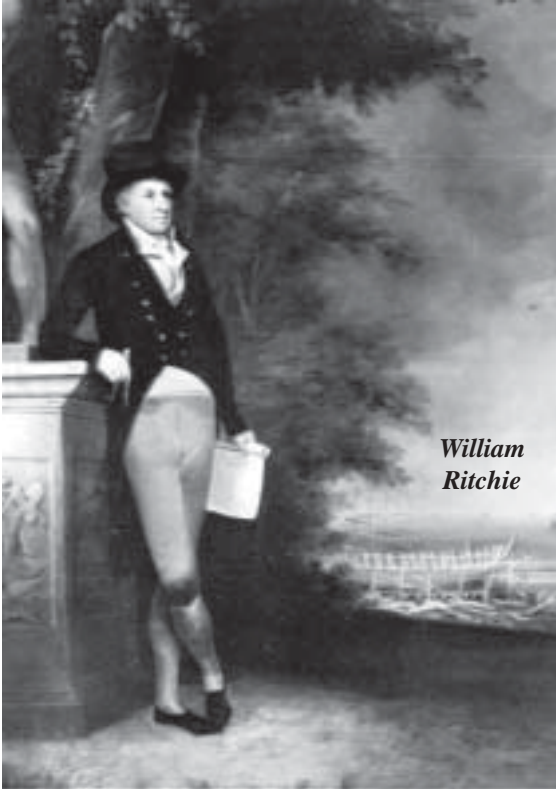

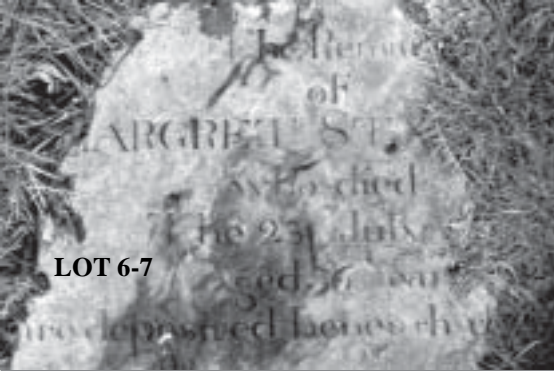

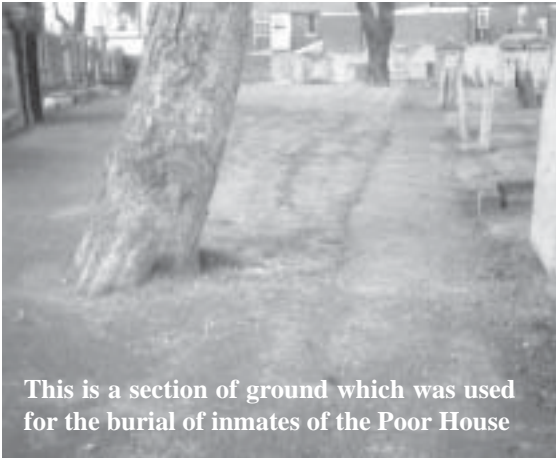
